Position

San Marco Veterinary Clinic, a recognised ECVAA satellite centre, offers a position for an alternative resident in Veterinary Anesthesia and Analgesia. San Marco Veterinary Clinic is a state of the art tertiary hospital with a high case load in small animals anaesthesia, analgesia and intensive care, while appropriate externships (large, exotics, laboratory animals anaesthesia) will be organized in order to fulfill the requirements established by the European College of Veterinary Anesthesia and Analgesia (ECVAA) for board certification.

Requirements

The candidate should have completed a rotating internship of at least 12 months or should have an equivalent clinical experience. Knowledge of Italian is desirable as well as good knowledge of English.

- two reference letters
- certificates (undergraduate studies and internship certificate, etc)
- veterinary licensing documentation

Deadline

The 3-year program is available to start from **October 2022**.

After an initial probationary period, appointments will be made for 12 months, with annual renewal based on satisfactory completion of the previous year.

Deadline for application is **June 30th 2022**.
