



Three - year Residency Training Programme in Clinical Pathology at San Marco Veterinary Clinic and Laboratory

Position

San Marco Veterinary Laboratory offers a position for a resident in Clinical Pathology (ECVCP). San Marco is one of the most advanced veterinary laboratories in the world with a large caseload (more than 150,000 samples per year), accredited as an ECVPC training center for all disciplines: hematology, clinical chemistry, hemostasis, urinalysis, endocrinology and cytology. The facility also includes the San Marco Veterinary Clinic, a state-of-the-art tertiary hospital with a high case load in small animal medicine. The resident will rotate in the various departments of the lab in a stimulating, scientifically avant-garde and multidisciplinary environment, in close contact with boarded specialists from other disciplines (ECVIM, ECVD, ECVF).

Requirements

The candidate must have completed a rotating internship of at least 12 months or have an equivalent clinical experience. Italian language skills are not initially required, since we are used to international staff; fluency in written and spoken English is mandatory. Interviews will take place in presence; dates and times will be notified to short listed candidates.

- letter of intent
- two reference letters
- certificates (undergraduate studies and internship certificate, etc)
- veterinary licensing documentation

The 3-year program is available to start from September 2022. Deadline for application is **July 30th, 2022**.
