

Three - year Residency Training Programme in Behavioural Medicine

Position

San Marco is currently accepting applications for a 3-year standard residency program in Behavioural Medicine, which will begin in April 2026. San Marco Veterinary Clinic is a state-of-the art tertiary hospital with an annual caseload of approximately 11000 patients.

Requirements

Applicants must have successfully completed a 12-months rotating internship or have similar clinical experience with a focus on behavioural medicine. It is preferable to have knowledge of both Italian and English. Publications in peer-reviewed journals and academic or recognized titles in behavioural medicine and animal welfare are recommended. The short-listed candidates will be informed of the dates and times of the in-person interviews. By February 28th 2026, interviews will be conducted in person. Prior to the interview, short-listed candidates are encouraged to visit San Marco Veterinary Clinic.

- letter of intent
- two reference letters
- certificates (degree, internship certificate, professional titles)
- veterinary licensing documentation
